

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-11-159

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 12.04 “SIGNS,” SECTION 12.04.005 “ON-SITE REGULATIONS,” BY AMENDING PART (b) “COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS,” SUBPART C “HEIGHT,” OF (2) “ATTACHED SIGNS,” PARAGRAPH (iv), AND AMENDING SECTION 12.04.016 “PROHIBITED SIGN LOCATIONS AND TYPES,” BY AMENDING PART (a) “PROHIBITIONS,” (1) “PROHIBITED LOCATIONS,” SUBPART “E” TO LIMIT THE REGULATION TO SIGNS PROJECTING INTO THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SAN ANGELO, TEXAS:

Section 1. That Chapter 12, Article 12.04 “Signs,” Section 12.04.005 “On Site Regulations,” is hereby amended, by amending Part (b) “Commercial Districts,” subpart C “Height” of (2) “Attached Signs,” paragraph iv, to read as follows:

“Sec. 12.04.005 On-site regulations, (b) Commercial Districts, (2) Attached Signs, (C) Height, (iv):

(iv) Any projecting sign larger than sixteen (16) square feet that extends into the public right-of-way shall be subject to approval of city council on consideration of the purposes of this Article 12.04, after notice and public hearing ~~to consider whether the proposed placement shall infringe upon neighboring business’s rights to be seen and to consider any other detrimental effect it might have.~~

Section 2. That Chapter 12, Article 12.04 “Signs,” is hereby amended, by amending section 12.04.016(a)(1)(E) “Prohibited Sign Locations” to read as follows:

Sec. 12.04.016 Prohibited sign locations and types, (a) Prohibitions, (1) Prohibited Locations, (E):

(E) Signs placed upon public rights-of-way, except as allowed elsewhere in this Chapter, without the express permission of the city council are prohibited.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and of the Code of Ordinances of the City of San Angelo, Texas, as amended, except where the provisions

of this Ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and such Code, in which event conflicting provisions of such ordinances and such Code are hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or the application of same to any person or set of circumstances, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, void or invalid, or for any reason unenforceable, the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or their application to other persons or sets of circumstances shall not be affected thereby, it being the intent of the City Council in adopting this Ordinance that no portion hereof or provision or regulation contained herein shall become inoperative or fail by reason of any unconstitutionality or invalidity of any other portion, provision, or regulation of this Ordinance.

Section 5. That this Ordinance shall be effective on, from and after the date of adoption.
