Executive Summary

- **96-Gallon Cart System**
 - Weekly Trash – cart contents only
 - Weekly Recycling-(allowable & non-allowable items)
 - Trash & Recycle Carts serviced same day each week
 - Estimated delivery of carts – late May/early June
 - “Go Live date” with cart system - mid-July
 - Do not use carts until “go live date”
 - Current service will continue until “go live date”

 - 5-yard limit
- **Bi-Annual Electronics Recycling Event**
 - Partnering with SAFE (dates to be announced)

Where should I put my Cart?

On your collection day, you should place your carts either:

- At the curb by the street

OR

- Within 2 feet of the alley

PROPER CART PLACEMENT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT. On your collection day, please roll your cart within 2 feet of the edge of the street by 7:00 a.m. Make sure the handles are facing your house, so that when the cart is lifted, the lid opens toward the street. Please check to see that it is not obstructed by parked cars, boats, etc.

New Curbside Recycling Cart Program Frequently Asked Questions



When should I place my cart out for service? Be sure your cart is at the curb by 7:00 a.m. to ensure collection. You may set your cart out the night before if you wish. Please pull your cart back to the house after it has been emptied.

Where should I place my cart for service? Roll your cart to the curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Make sure the handles are facing your house and the cart is not obstructed by any objects.

What can I put in my green recycling cart? Plastic products (except plastic bags & bubble wrap), paper products, aluminum cans, tin cans. Please flatten cardboard boxes and place them inside your cart. See website for a complete list of recyclable items.

What if I have more than a 96 gallon cart will hold? After all carts have been delivered you may call the City Utility Billing Dept. at 325.657.4323 to request an extra 96 gallon cart for an additional fee per month.

How does my recycling cart collection work? Just roll your green cart to the curb/alley by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. The cart is emptied mechanically from inside the Republic Services vehicle cab. The cart is picked up and emptied then set back in place and the truck moves on to the next collection stop.



What if a holiday falls on my collection day? Your service day and those following will be delayed by one day. For example, if the holiday falls on a Wednesday, the service day would be delayed to Thursday, Thursday to Friday and Friday to Saturday.

Who do I call for repairs on my cart? Call Republic Services Customer Service to request repair, cart delivery, or request a cart... 325.481.7700 For stolen or vandalized carts, file police report with SAPD. Then contact Republic Services for replacement with a copy of police report.

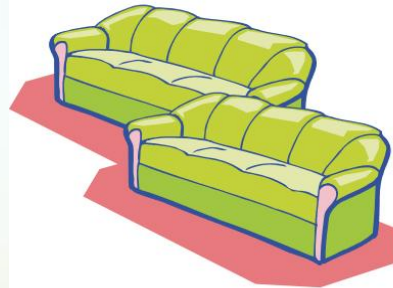

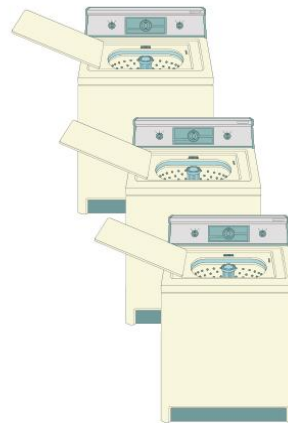

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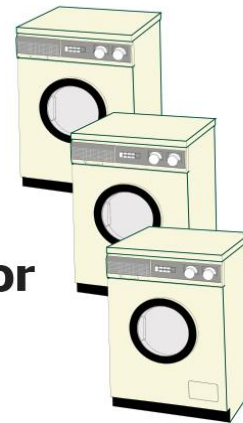
