Candice Brewer reported on the Friends of Fairmount activities and projects. Candice reported on the Friends of Fairmount Landscape Donation Policy as approved by the Friends of Fairmount Board. Houston Harte is the subject of an oral history project conducted by Angelo State University honor students.
