## **EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

Whereas, the City of San Angelo on the  $9^{th}$  day of February, 2021 has potential damage, injury, or impacts to health and human safety resulting from unknown contaminates in the water system.

Whereas, the Mayor of San Angelo has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and protect or rehabilitate property.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF SAN ANGELO:

- 1. The local state of emergency is hereby declared for the City of San Angelo pursuant to Ch. 418.108 (b) of the Texas Government Code
- 2. That pursuant to Chapter 418.108 (b) of the Texas Code of Government the state of emergency shall not continue for a period of not more than seven days from this date of declaration unless renewed by City Council of The City of San Angelo.
- 3. That pursuant to Chapter 418.108 (b) of the Texas Code of Government, this declaration of local emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Clerk of San Angelo.
- 4. That pursuant to Chapter 418.108 (b) of the Texas Code of Government, this declaration of emergency activates City/County emergency operations plan.

This proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after it issuance.
