Mr. Fernandez made a motion to pass all staff recommendations with one change of funding to 109 S Chadbourne to fund sprinkler system, instead of the façade improvements, in the amount of \$20,658.

Seconded by Ms. Hunt and passed unanimously.

Mr. Gayler made a motion to fund the remaining TIRZ South projects at 75 percent of the eligible expenses, after subtracting the 25% match, using available funds from the North TIRZ. Staff explained that a supermajority vote is required to recommend using funds from the North to fund projects in the South. In addition, City Council must also approve by a supermajority.

Mr. Brown seconded the motion, which was approved unanimously.

VI. Discussion of the possibility of funding South projects with North funds

Mr. Gaylor made a motion to go back to previous agenda item. Motion was seconded by Mr. Brown and motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Brown made a motion to combine existing TIRZ North and South funds and to split them equally between North and South and in future years to split TIRZ revenue evenly between North and South, rather than the current split which has revenue in the North going to the North fund and revenue in the South going to the South fund.

Mr. Cummings seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
