

Signs & Markings Policy

The signs/ markings personnel are responsible for the installation, repair, maintenance and removal of the traffic control signs/ markings throughout the City. The exception to this rule at TXDOT controlled thoroughfares. Projects currently in place include the upgrade of sign reflectivity, breakaway sign post and long term pavement markings.

Any signs posted adjacent to roadways, alleyways or posted in the City of San Angelo right of way must adhere to the MUTCD maintenance and retro-reflectivity standard: (Section 2A.08 Retro reflectivity and Illumination) and (Section 1A.05 Maintenance of Traffic Control Devices) in order to insure continuing adherence to the MUTCD standards, all signs shall be constructed on a durable substrate such as aluminum. All sign legends shall be applied onto a retro-reflective background and shall be stabilized against ultra- violet degradation to prevent rapid fading.

All signs installed in City of San Angelo right of way shall be documented in the GIS database with its current condition and location to ensure all signs are being monitored for compliance.
