
## San Angelo Neighborhoods — At a Glance

The San Angelo Airport Neighborhood is located in the southwest section of San Angelo. Knickerbocker Road, also known as Texas Highway 584, runs north and southwards, and borders the neighborhood to the west. This main thoroughfare also provides an important gateway in and out of the city. This neighborhood includes Mathis Field and the San Angelo Regional Airport, the sole commercial airport serving the Concho Valley. The airport includes more than 150 aircrafts that area based in Mathis Field and three intersecting runways that operate 24 hours a day, servicing commercial, private, and military aviation. The airport generates more than \$1.2 million dollars annually. Because there are no residents living in the neighborhood, data indicated for the Neighborhood profile are not applicable.


