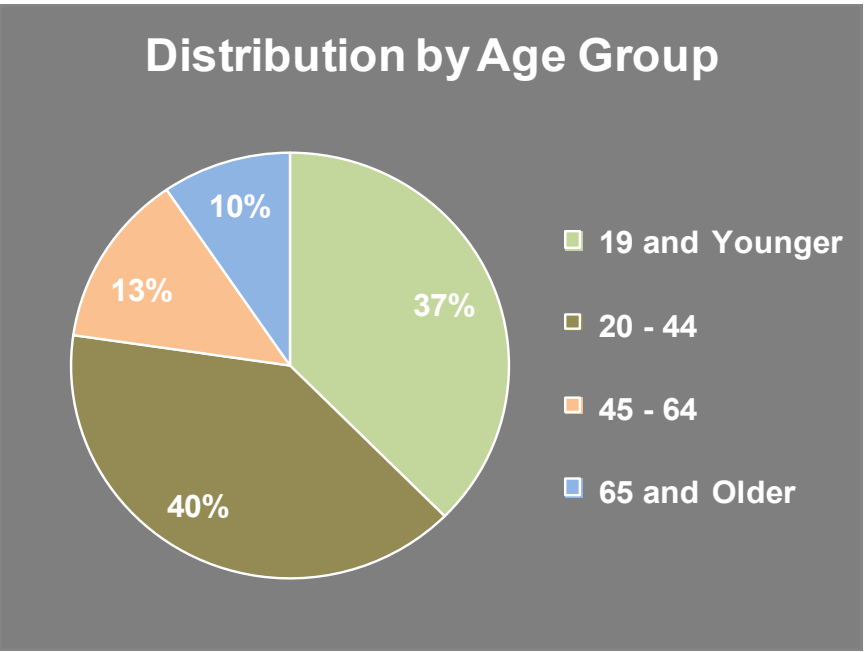


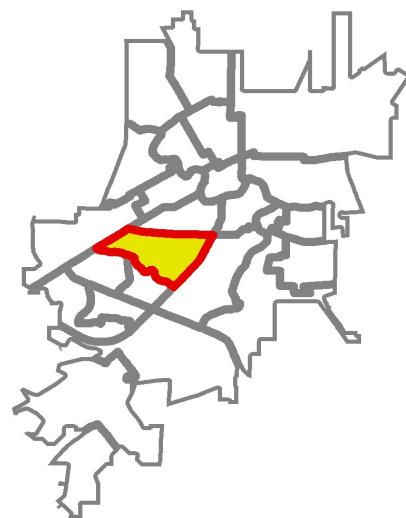
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The ASU - College Hills Neighborhood is home to Angelo State University which was founded in 1928. ASU offers both undergraduate and graduate programs. The campus contains approximately 268 acres. Important roadways running through this neighborhood include Avenue N, to the north, and Knickerbocker Road, to the east. Commercial opportunities are clustered along these streets and aside from the campus, outlying areas are characterized by a sea of dense housing stock. The Red Arroyo is a destination for recreation and borders the neighborhood to the south. PAYS School, Glenn Middle School and Crocket Elementary School are located in and around the campus as is the Administration Building for San Angelo Independent School District.
