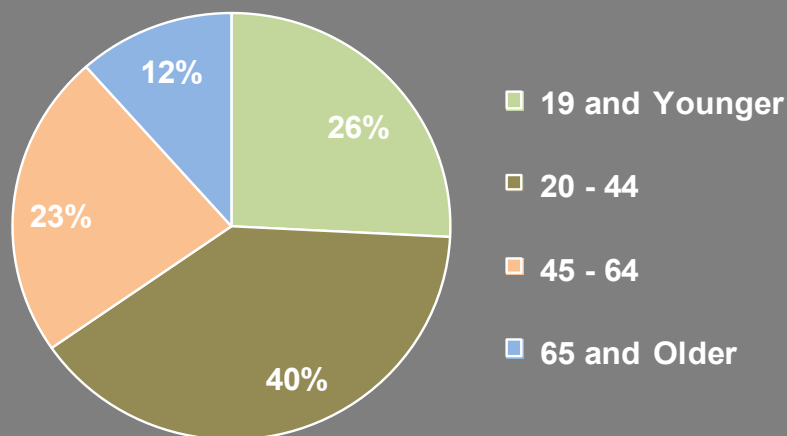


San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Blackshear Neighborhood is located west of Martin Luther King Drive. The Chicken Farm Art Center, founded in 1971, hosts monthly activities showcasing artistic works and hand made products as well as serves to be a consistent cultural and entertainment magnet which draws patrons there throughout the community and beyond. One of the Blackshear Neighborhood's main recreational features is the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Park. This is a 4 acre park containing a basketball court and large sandy playground area with state of the art playground equipment. Blackshear Head Start is located in the middle of this neighborhood, west of North Bryant Boulevard. Housing stock within the neighborhood is characterized by a moderately dense saturation of older homes.

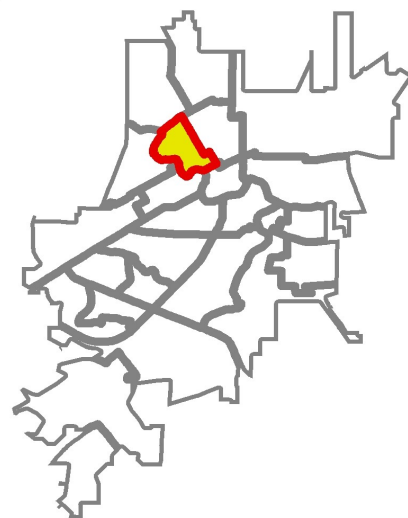
