
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Bonham Neighborhood hosts a healthy mixture of residential housing types ranging from patio and single family detached homes to apartments; all within a relatively concentrated area. Southland Boulevard runs north to south of the neighborhood along the eastern border of the neighborhood, and is a major street connecting traffic to West Loop 306. Sherwood Way, located at the western border, is an established commercial corridor that includes major retail stores such as WalMart, Sam's Club and Lowe's. Bonham Elementary School serves many K - 5 students within the southwestern section of the city.
