San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

One of the jewels of the Central Neighborhood is the world-famous water lily gardens, owned and operated by the City of San Angelo. This neighborhood also hosts Central High School, located in the east portion of the neighborhood. Austin Elementary serves this neighborhood, as well. Main thoroughfares include W. Beauregard Avenue, which borders the southern portion and Pecos Street and the Houston Harte Expressway, which bisects the neighborhood, east to west. The Concho River serves as the eastern most boundary of the neighborhood. Like many of the neighborhoods that border the river, these residences are typical of older housing containing a variety of pre-WWII period housing architectural styles that vary from Victorian to Bungalow. W. Beauregard serves connector Sherwood way to the Central Business District.




