
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

West Loop 306 is the northernmost boundary for the Country Club Neighborhood. The central portion is best characterized by its large private golf club with its upscale housing skirting the fringes of the golf course. The west side is experiencing a rapid growth in housing stock whereby newly annexed properties continue to stretch the City Limits southward and westward to Sherwood Way. Housing, therefore, on the west side of the neighborhood is characteristically more dense than that on the east. Community facilities include Bonham Elementary School and Fire Station #2, which are located on the northwestern portion of the neighborhood.


MONTHLY RENTAL vs MORTGAGE RATES
