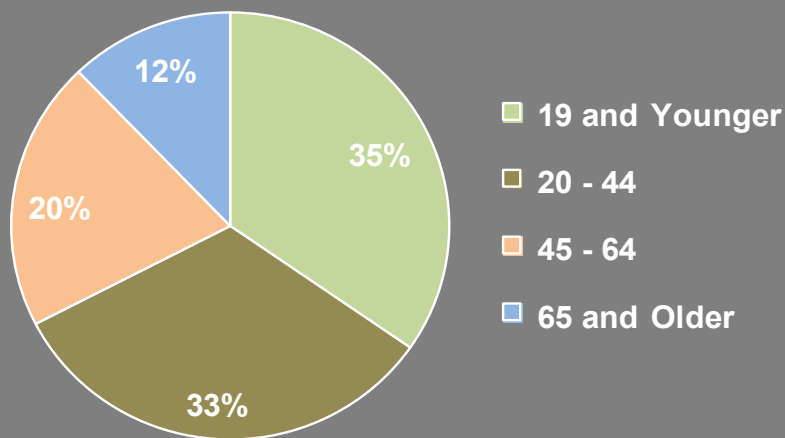


# San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

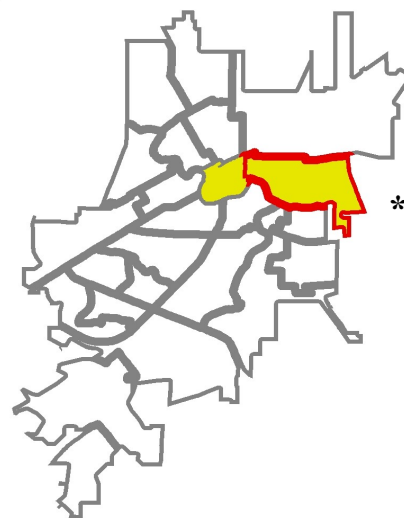
The Ft. Concho East Neighborhood is situated directly east of the downtown area. Bell Street is the major roadway that runs north to south, with a mixture of light to medium commercial and residential uses. The remaining eastern half of the neighborhood contains Quicksand Golf Course, an 18-hole privately owned facility covering an area of over 500 acres in an area which remains undeveloped. Bell Street, similar to Main Street, is an important thoroughfare that links the Houston Harte Expressway Loop to the neighborhood. San Jacinto Elementary School is also located centrally within this neighborhood. The Texas Sports Bank Complex is situated along the southern boundary of the neighborhood, north of the Concho River.
