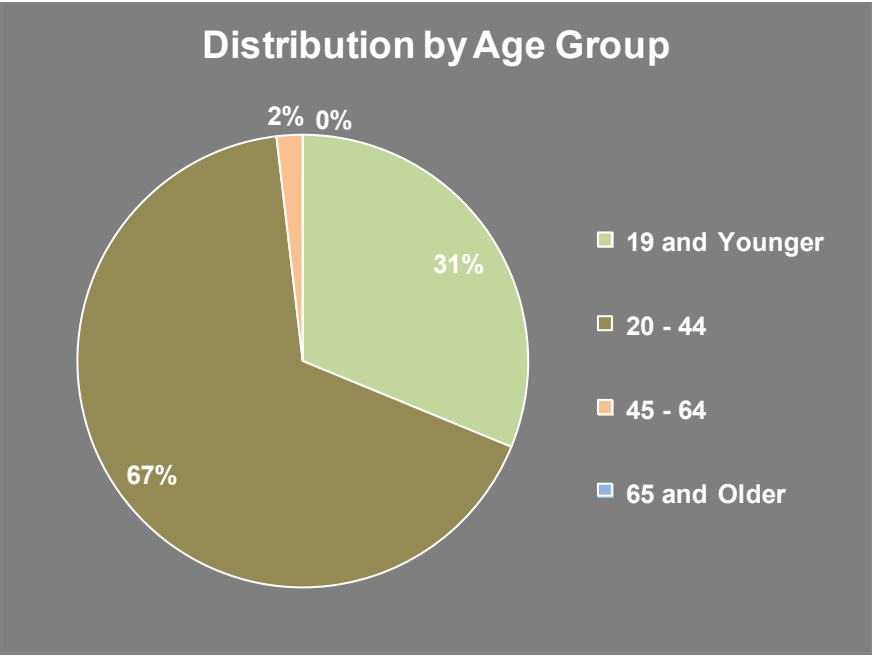


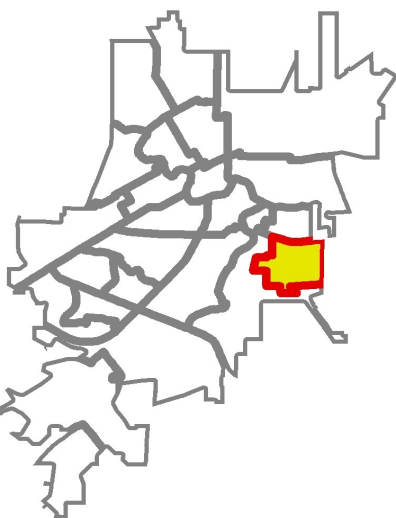
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

Goodfellow Air Force Base is the largest employer in the city, and was founded, as we know it today, in December 1947 as a pilot school for the United States Air Force. It was formally designated on June 21, 1940, during World War II as a pilot training facility. Over time, more permanent on-base housing has been added in response to the need for housing. The facility initially opened in August 1940 as the San Angelo Corps Basic Flying Training School. In the late 1970s, the base was returned to the Air Training Command. As time progressed—the base began to provide more intelligent services. By 1985, it was designated as a technical training center. In the 1990s the base went underwent extensive modernization and continues to serve of a central intelligence of the Force.
