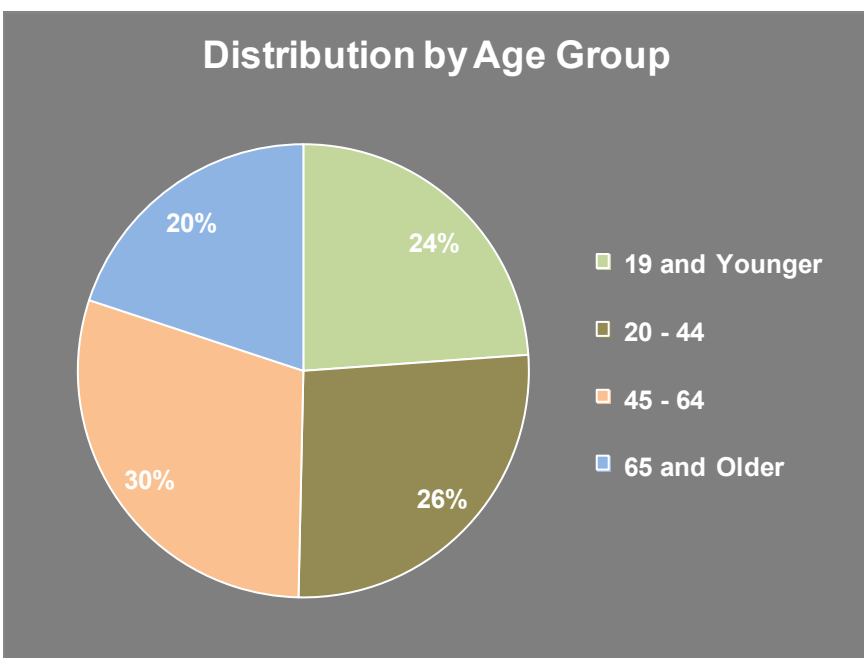


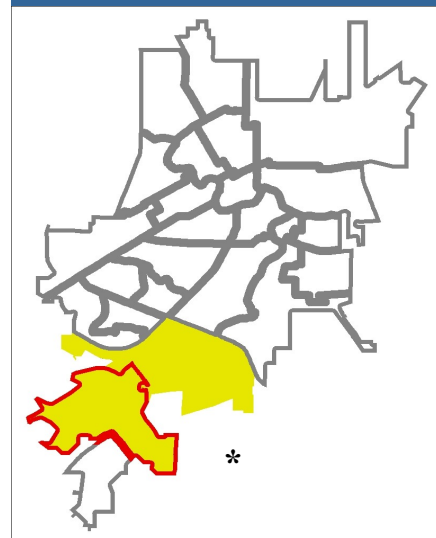
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Nasworthy Neighborhood is best identified as one of the city's most important recreational attractors. A wide variety of activities take place in this neighborhood, including annual world-class boat races and the annual 4th of July firework display show, which lights up the skies overhead and can be enjoyed from miles around. A quick getaway from the hustle and bustle of the city, the area offers a destination spot for boating, fishing, camping and sightseeing and features the San Angelo Nature Center where a variety of exotic animals and native animals are showcased. Lake front properties are characterized by a mix of housing types. The Lake Nasworthy Master Plan document, made possible by citizen involvement, was completed in November 2013 and catalogues area resources.
