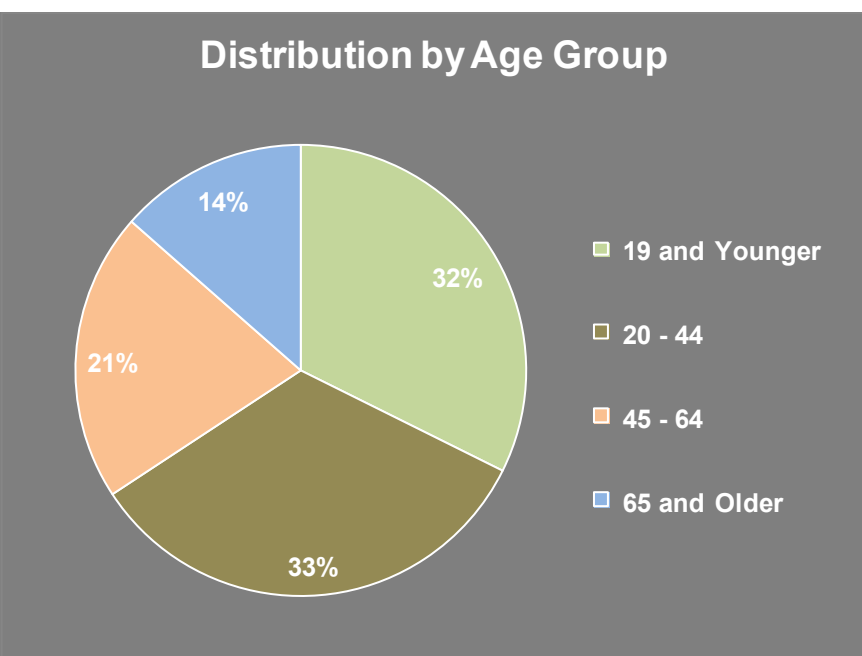


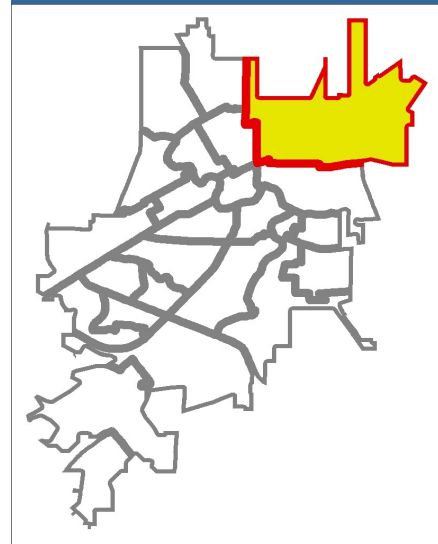
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Paulann Neighborhood encompasses roughly 7.25 miles of highway which include Old Ballinger Highway and Highway 277. This eastern area is best characterized by Howard College and Ethicon, Inc., a producer of surgical equipment and one of the city's largest employers. Baptist Memorial Geriatric Center, also an important employer, is located within the southwestern section of the neighborhood. This neighborhood is home the city's only landfill site. Old Ballinger Highway serves as a major connector for industrial freight moment. North Bell Street, located north of Houston Harte Expressway, is an established commercial corridor in the area and serves to connect the neighborhood to the Houston Harte Expressway to the south.
