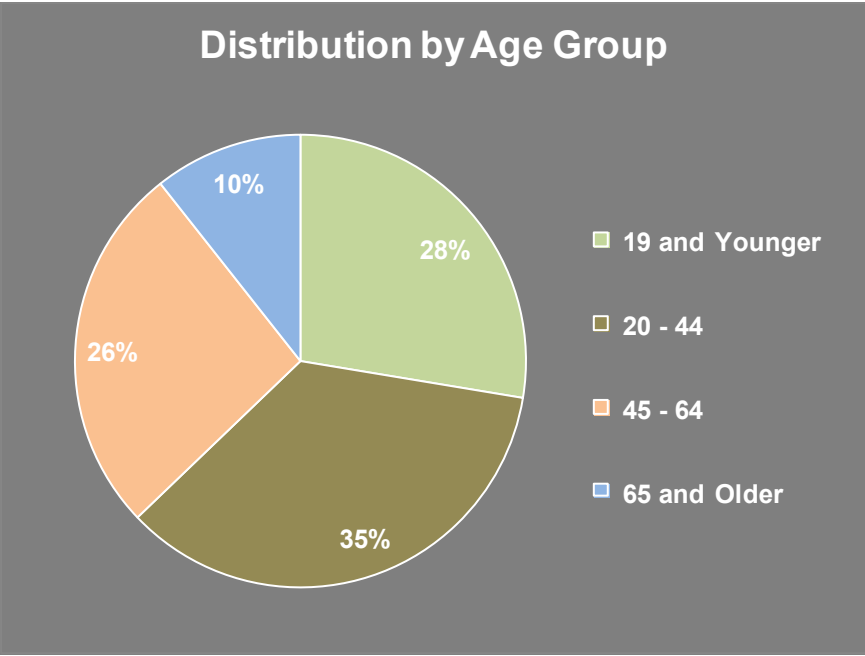


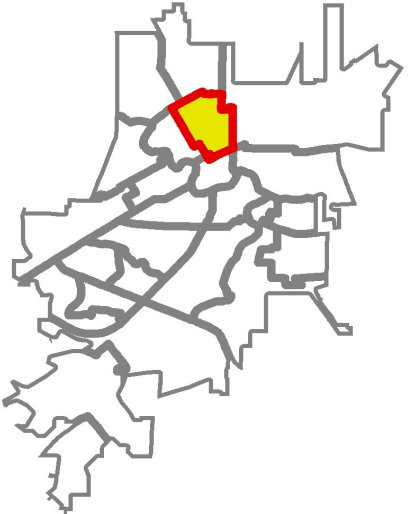
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The majority of blocks within the Reagan Neighborhood are residential. Blocks on the western side of the neighborhood located situated in a northwest, southwest direction. Central connecting streets include 29th Street bordering the north, 19th Street, which runs east to west, respectively, and North Chadbourne Street, which runs northwest to southeast. Main Street borders the neighborhood to the east. Reagan Elementary School is located on the western side of this neighborhood.
