
San Angelo Neighborhoods— At a Glance

The Santa Rita Neighborhood overall represents one of the oldest affluent neighborhoods in the city, and is characterized by an eclectic mix of architectural housing types. Properties housing mansions front the south shore of the Concho River and provide attractive visual interest to both motorists and pedestrians alike who are enjoying the scenic river view from the public golf course and paths on the north side of the river. Additionally, these river front properties contain some of the spectacular annual holiday light displays held by the City of San Angelo's Parks and Recreation's Department. Santa Rita Elementary School is situated near the heart of this neighborhood, which is ideal for a walk-able community.
