

TEMPORARY ADDRESSING (PRE-DEVELOPMENT)

- The assignment of addresses at this stage in the development process is strictly temporary and provided as a service so that I may schedule and begin the installation of infrastructure required prior to permitting.
- These temporary addresses may be changed - by adjustments to numbering and/or street name - prior to the permitting process.
- These addresses are not authorized for release to the public, except by the 911 Addressing Coordinator. They are not to be utilized in advertising.
- If a subdivision plat is required for development, temporary addresses may be issued according to a draft plat. Before addresses are made permanent, the plat must be approved and recorded, and the information provided to the City. Permits for construction may not be obtained until this occurs.
- If a subdivision plat is not required for development, temporary addresses may be issued if the requestor provides a copy of the relevant deed(s) for the property & a copy(ies) of the tax appraisal information with the owner's name and official current legal description. Before addresses are made permanent, the site plan must be submitted for approval. Permits for construction may not be obtained until this occurs.
