The following clarifications, changes, additions, and/or deletions are hereby made to the specifications and contract documents from questions relating to this RFP:

Questions/Answers:

1. What waste(s) are being composted?

- Human waste only - Windrows are constructed by mixing finished compost with a solids concentration of about 80% at a ratio of either 1:1 or 2:1 with the wet digested sludge.

2. What is the annual volume/tons of waste being composted annually?

- From August 2013 to July 2014 approximately 11,460 cubic yards of anaerobically digested sludge with a solids concentration of approximately 21% was delivered to the composting facility. The dry weight of the material averaged 1759 lbs/cubic yard.

3. What is the size of the area for windrows?

- Approximately 6.5 acres of concrete working surface

4. How many total hours has it been used to date?

- Hours as of Sept. 3rd: 2647 hrs

6. Have any major replacements of major parts (engine, hydraulic drum drive pumps and/or motors, etc., been done?

- Several Hydraulic pumps replaced, radiator replaced from animal damage (engine cooling), no other major components replaced
- When will the City stop using the trade-in machine? The City will make every effort to keep the machine in a similar condition as it was appraised (good working order). However, operation of the machine will continue until its replacement is operation on site. Bidders should appropriately plan the trade-in value around this aspect.
